## **NOTICE** about changes to the provisions of the invitation to submit offers

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The Ordering Party informs that in Chapter IX of the Invitation to submit offers, the provisions of section 6 of the document, which is replaced by the following:

"The Ordering Party shall invalidate the contract award procedure, in particular if no offer is submitted, or all submitted offers are rejected, or the price of the most advantageous offer exceeds the amount that the Ordering Party can allocate to finance the order, or other justified circumstances occur resulting in the invalidity of the contract. Moreover, the Ordering Party may cancel the contract award procedure before the deadline for submitting offers if circumstances occur that make further conduct of the procedure unjustified.."
