Refers: The procedure for the award of a contract in the field of science is conducted by means of the procedure for the announcement of an invitation for tenders, pursuant to Article 11 paragraph 5 item 1 of the Law of September 11, 2019. - Public Procurement Law (i.e. Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] of 2023, item 1605 as amended), hereinafter referred to as the "PPL" and the Law of April 23, 1964. - Civil Code (i.e. Dz. U. of 2023, item 1610 as amended), for the the Selection of a Contractor for the Provision of Online Social Survey Services for the Institute of Psychology of the Jagiellonian University in the Framework of the GRIEG Project "From Apathy to Violent Extremism: Motivational Basis of Political Engagement", Divided into Two Parts of the Subject Matter.

NOTIFICATION OF THE CANCELLATION OF THE PROCEDURE OF PART I AND PART II OF THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THE CONTRACT

Dear Sirs,

We would like to kindly inform that based on the provisions of Chapter XIV of the Invitation to tender, the Principal shall cancel the contract award procedure as the price of the best tender exceeds the amount that the Principal may allocate to finance the contract, and the Principal cannot increase it to the price of the best tender.

The Principal allocated for the implementation of the subject matter of the contract the following amounts: 170 246,99 PLN gross (part I) and 14 715,78 PLN gross (part II).

Offer number 5 submitted by Ogólnopolski Panel Badawczy Sp. z o. o., Podbipinaty 57, 02-732 Warszawa, amounted to 207 034,00 PLN gross (part I of the subject matter of the contract) and 22 189,00 PLN gross (part II of the subject matter of the contract).

Offer number 2 submitted by Market Research World Anna Sojka, ul. Mastalerza 26/13, 44-102 Gliwice, amounted to 485 407,20 PLN gross (part I of the subject matter of the contract) and 49 200,00 PLN gross (part II of the subject matter of the contract).

At the same time, we would like to inform that in both part I and part II of the subject matter of the contract:

- 1) offer number 1 submitted by Qualtrics XM, 333 W. River Park Dr., Provo, UT 84604, United States, based on the provisions of Chapter VI section 3 of the Invitation to tender was rejected due to the fact that it is inconsistent with the terms of the Invitation. The offer was submitted without the required form, i.e. it did not bear the required signature as well as the offer price was expressed in a foreign currency, while Principal required the offer price to be presented in PLN;
- 2) offer number 3 submitted by DANA E Sp. z o. o., ul. Bora Komorowskiego 19b, 80-377 Gdańsk, based on the provisions of Chapter VI section 3 of the Invitation to tender was rejected due to the fact that the contractor made a change to the content of the offer at the stage of the procedure, i.e.

after opening the offers. During the verification and examination of the offers, the Principal asked the contractor to clarify the statement contained in the offer relating to the database of active respondents. In response to the Principal request, the Contractor indicated that third parties would be involved in the order execution process, which the contractor did not include in the submitted offer, directly stating in Appendix number 3 to the offer form that there would be no subcontractors involved in the implementation of any part (scope) of the subject matter of the contract. In the Principal's opinion, the above contradiction with the Contractor's original statements had to be considered as an unacceptable change to the content of the offer, and therefore the Principal was obliged to reject it. Due to the fact that the Contractor classified the provided explanations as a business secret, the ordering party refrained from publishing detailed information in this regard;

- 3) offer number 4 submitted by Dynata GmbH Amtsgericht Frankfurt am Main, HRB 76760, Germany, based on the provisions of Chapter VI section 3 of the Invitation to tender was rejected due to the fact that it is inconsistent with the terms of the Invitation. The offer was submitted without the required form, i.e. it did not bear the required signature as well as the offer price was expressed in a foreign currency, while Principal required the offer price to be presented in PLN. Additionally, the contractor did not clearly indicate the price for part I of the subject matter of the contract and part II of the subject of the contract, providing the total amount for both parts in the calculation table as well as including an additional item (service) unforeseen by the Principal in the calculation.
